#### MEET TRACY



At the age of just 25 years, Tracy Dinh, a dear friend, girlfriend, daughter, and sister, was diagnosed with Stage 4 Small Cell Cervical Cancer (SCCC) in November 2011.

This is a rare and aggressive form of cancer with a poor prognosis. Her diagnosis was a shock to all of her friends and family.



#### MEET TRACY

Tracy bravely fought for the next few months, maintaining her dignity while still wanting to do things on her own. Her sense of humour and inner strength never left her, even while the cancer was slowly taking her life.

Tracy took her last breath on May 13, 2012, mother's day morning, in the loving arms of her father and mother.

#### MEET TRACY

The Pink Wig Foundation was created in Tracy's legacy to increase awareness about the devastating diagnosis of cancer for young women. One of Tracy's last wishes was to provide financial support through this foundation to relieve cancer patients and their families. Tracy hopes that this would allow these individuals to focus on getting healthy as they fight the most difficult battle of their lives.

Although our dear friend Tracy has passed away, her memories, wisdom, and love for others will never be forgotten. As we move forward, we will carry on the legacy of Tracy Dinh with us by honouring her last wishes to serve and provide for those in need through The Pink Wig Foundation.



#### MEET RAE

Rae was diagnosed with Triple Negative Breast Cancer, one of the most aggressive, difficult to treat and often reoccurs, in 2021. As a woman, mother, grandmother, and wife, life changed quickly to say the least.

"This was definitely the lowest point thus far in my short-lived life, but after sharing bits and pieces on social media, I gained the biggest support system I could have ever imagined! By far the greatest connection came from The Pink Wig Foundation.

The funding support has eased my mind when I needed it the most. Being able to carry on with bill payments, children's needs, etc. has me so very grateful. To focus on the treatment and healing process without the nightmare of unpaid bills gives us much needed hope."

#### MEET KAYLA

After finding a lump, Kayla was worried as cancers run in her family. After a mammogram, ultrasound, and a biopsy, she was diagnosed with Stage 2 Invasive Mammary Carcinoma. Recovery was lonely during the pandemic, but her kids kept her busy at home and pushed her to keep fighting.

"Taking time off work was difficult for me as I always worked hard to help support my family and had recently gone back to college. Even with being on EI, I watched as my savings slowly drained down to nothing. I was saving up for a down payment for a future home.

Receiving support from the Pink Wig will help me to catch up on bills and relieve some of the financial stress that is still weighing on my mind. I will be forever grateful."





Christine's journey started with an odd lump found by chance. Her whole world stopped. The following weeks were a blur. Then she heard the words 'Breast Cancer'. Chemo/surgery/radiation. All of it, one after another. After nearly a year of treatment she found out by happenstance that she also had a primary Lung Cancer. Surgery was successful and she was given the good news that they 'got it all'.

"What I know for sure is that without Breast Cancer I would have never found the Lung Cancer. This journey has been very hard but I am confident there has been some miracles happening here!"
